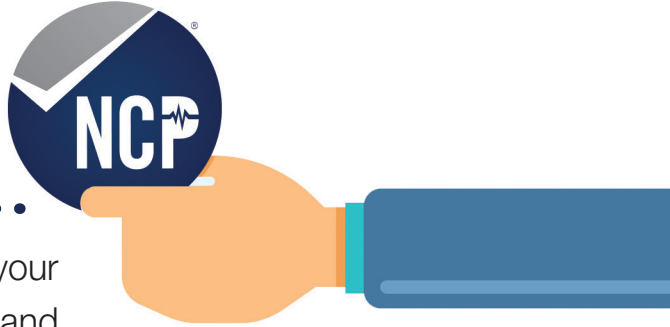


I WANT TO BECOME AN NCP! WHERE CAN I GET HELP?

EPCOR administers a *National Check Payments Certification Prep Program* to assist you in preparing for the National Check Payments Exam, administered annually by the Electronic Check Clearing House Organization (ECCHO).
